Port Tasting Wrap-up

On Saturday, April 26, LBNC members and guests spent a lovely evening at the home of Aras and Daphne Butas, experiencing Port and sampling a delicious array of homemade neighborhood desserts. We were lucky the rain held out most of the evening and we mingled in their home as well as on their back patio.

We tasted Port styles such as Ruby, Tawny, Reserva and Vintage Port. Our six samples included; a Ruby and Tawny by Ferreira, a 10 year Tawny by Graham's, a Late Bottle Vintage (LBV) called Quinto Crasto, a reserve called Ferreira Donia Antonia and, finally, a Vintage Port known as Churchill Grahams Quinta Gricha.

We learned a bit of the history of Port and where it comes from as well as stories about how each of the Ports were named. The Ports and the pourers were provided by Arrow Wine of Arlington, which is a fabulous little wine and cheese shop to visit, if you've never been.

Next Event: Yo Ho Ho and a Bottle of Rum!

Please join the Newcomers' Club for a Rum Tasting on **Saturday, May 31st from 7pm - 11pm at the home of Gary and Debbie McManis, 6337 Waterway Drive.**

Join us as we sail into uncharted waters; sipping a selection of fine, handcrafted rum from Martinique and Guyana. Rhum Agricole (as it is known) is made from pure cane juice, not molasses (a by-product of sugar manufacturing) like most rums available here in the USA. This leads to a unique, smooth, sugar cane spirit of high quality. The rums we will taste are analogous to fine single-malt scotches and are hand-crafted in the Caribbean by small, traditional producers. **Pirates never had it this good!**

Ed Hamilton, also known as the Minister of Rum (www.ministryofrum.com), will be on hand to guide and educate our palates. He is the author of four books on rum, has tasted over 300 varieties, and currently lives on his sailboat in the Caribbean where he plies the tropical waters in search of superior rum.

Please bring a heavy appetizer dish to share with 10-12 other guests. Food should be finger food (hot dip & chips, pizzas, cheese & crackers, dumplings, cold cuts, steak bites, finger sandwiches, wings, taquitos, satay, etc.) and should not require utensils to eat.

The event is \$15 for Newcomers' Club members and \$20 for non-members. This is an advance-payment event. Your check is your reservation.
